In April, a woven leather chair caught the attention of Paul and Peter Bentel, the architects behind the Modern restaurant at the newly expanded Museum of Modern Art. They asked its designer, Mark Albrecht, if he had a bar stool version. He didn't, but has since created the stool, above, and 22 are in the restaurant.
